Meeting called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Dr. Lisa Kapler.

Agenda reviewed, motion made by Dave Tice to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Rosemary Tobin, motion carried.

Minutes from the May 16, 2016 meeting reviewed. Motion made by Denise Pavlovich to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Dave Tice, motion carried.


Gail Arjes, Floyd County Public Health/Home Health Care

Fiscal year end budget reviewed, no concerns noted. Unused funds will go back into the county general fund.

Agency policy and procedures reviewed and signed by Board Chair.

Standing Orders for immunizations, immunization reactions, and Mantoux testing reviewed and signed by the Medical Director. Gail will get clarification from IDPH on Mantoux testing for Home Care workers.

Changes to the Floyd County Handbook were reviewed. The Board would like clarification on "dependent" children before signing off. Gail will contact the Auditor for clarification.

Fiscal year end budget reviewed ended year at 96.13%

Dangerous Dog Ordinance was reviewed and discussed. Jeff will make changes that were discussed and email out to the Board for review.

Discussion and vote on Jeff taking over tattoo, tanning, and pools for Mitchell County. Jeff explained that the state was looking for another County to take over the inspections for Mitchell County because their sanitarian no longer wanted to do them. Motion made by Dave Tice for Jeff to take over the inspections for Mitchell County and have Dr. Kapler sign contract when he gets it. Motion seconded by Rosemary Tobin, motion carried.


Jeff informed the Board that he has been elected to the IOWWA (Iowa Onsite Waste Water Association) to fill a vacancy for the next year.

Jeff updated the Board on old nuisance complaint and one new complaint. The old complaint has been cleaned up and Jeff showed the picture of that and the new complaint was discussed and although they have a lot of stuff in the yard it was determined that it did not pose a public health risk. The Board directed Jeff to send a letter to the people that had submitted complaints to explain the Boards decision.

Jeff presented the Board with a septic variance for Rebecca Gors at Carville cabins to add a leach field to her holding tank. The variance is for the 100' setback from a well to the leach field. She would like to be 70' instead. Jeff explained that the two wells that are within the 70' are new wells and are grouted down to the lime stone and the cabin only has seasonal use. Motion by Rosemary Tobin to approve the variance for the 70' setback of the leach field from the two wells, second by Denise Pavlovich, motion carried.
