Minutes of the Floyd County Conservation Board June 2, 2020

The meeting was called to order by President, Dirk Uetz at 5:00 p.m. Present were Board Members: Beverly Fisher, Pete Kloberdanz, and Joel Cannon. Also present were Adam Sears, Heidi Reams, Tyler Walters, Tyron Steere, and Amy Boggess. Bev made a motion to accept the Consent Agenda, Joel seconded the motion and motion was carried. Pete moved to accept the meeting agenda and a second was made by Bev. Motion carried.

Citizens report: Roy Schurickenath brought up the fact that the courthouse has been reopened. He also mentioned that the board needs a new member, he suggested Linda Klemesrred.

Foundation Liaison Report: None

Adam Sears gave the Director's Report. Staff have been busy clearing brush at Idlewild, Tosanak, Cowell, and the Fossil & Prairie Park. We have been doing plumbing repairs at Colwell and Idlewild. New gravel has been put down at Idlewild, Tosanak, and Fossil & Prairie Park but we have more areas in need of this. Heidi has been busy doing Facebook live at 2:00 p.m Tuesdays and Thursdays. Construction was started at the new Fossil & Prairie shelter, that was done by Do It All. This year we have planted 175 spruce trees. We have begun spraying camp pads, food plots, etc. We have also repainted Ackley Creek shower house and next will be the Colwell Park south pit toilets. At Otter Ridge we have done several updates such as the steps and the ceiling. IWILL: the Governor said they are not moving forward this session. There are many different reservations coming in as well. We also have the new playground for Ackley ordered and the existing playground that is there now will be moved to Colwell Park.

New Business:

The new Floyd County ATV Ordinance was reviewed and the board was in agreement. Joel moved to raise the rental rate on the Darling Cabin and Lacey Lodge to \$75 starting July 1st, 2020. Bev seconded, and the motion was carried. The Office Assistant and Conservation Aid positions have been filled by Amy Boggess and Noah Reams.
