Charles City school district has a team of 15 trained personnel along with two registered nurses on staff that can assist Floyd County Public Health in contact tracing notifications. Public Health will be the contact for all positive cases and Charles City Schools will conduct the calls for those that are exposed to the positive case within the school district.
