Minutes of the Floyd County Conservation Board October 7, 2020

The meeting was called to order by President, Dirk Uetz at 5:34 p.m. Present were Board Members: Dirk Uetz, Beverly Fisher, Pam Folz, Joel Cannon, and Pete Kloberdanz. Also present were: Director, Adam Sears, and Naturalist, Heidi Reams. Bev made a motion to accept the Consent Agenda, Pete seconded the motion was carried. Joel moved to accept the meeting agenda and a second was made by Pam. Motion carried.

Citizens report:

Foundation Liaison Report: Bev reported that the next meeting will be 10/14/2020.

Director's Report:

Adam Sears gave the Director's Report. Hunting season is in full swing with more people out hunting. Youth deer hunting continues as well. At Gilman G. White Conservation Area there will be a pheasant hunt on October 24th. Gloria is helping with the REAP report as well as the Weed Commissioners Report. Slough Creek project started this week: establishing wetland 3-4ft. deep, 100yds. long x 65yds. wide, 20ft buffer between wetlands, and moving dirt to a food plot location. Staff have been working on boundary signs and have actually ran out of both signs and posts. Heidi and Amy have mostly taken over cleaning cabins at Tosanak. The playground at Ackley Creek Park is done, plus a new parking lot where the old playground was. Ackley Creek Bridge was recently fixed by Secondary Roads Dept. and it looks great. Winterizing facilities will start the week of October 19th.

Old Business:

Reviewed the salary comparison. The Board discussed Tyron's and Heidi's salaries to be caught up to the average salaries. The Board also suggested finding out what percent of an increase it will be for their salaries. Joel moved to table to November. Motion carried. Heidi is now doing some of her Environmental Education programs through zoom and doing very well. The Visitor Center is still closed, but continuing to set out Park Packs.

New Business:

The next meeting will be held on November 3rd at 5:00 p.m. at the Fossil and Prairie Center.

Joel moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:40 p.m. Pam seconded the motion and the motion carried.
